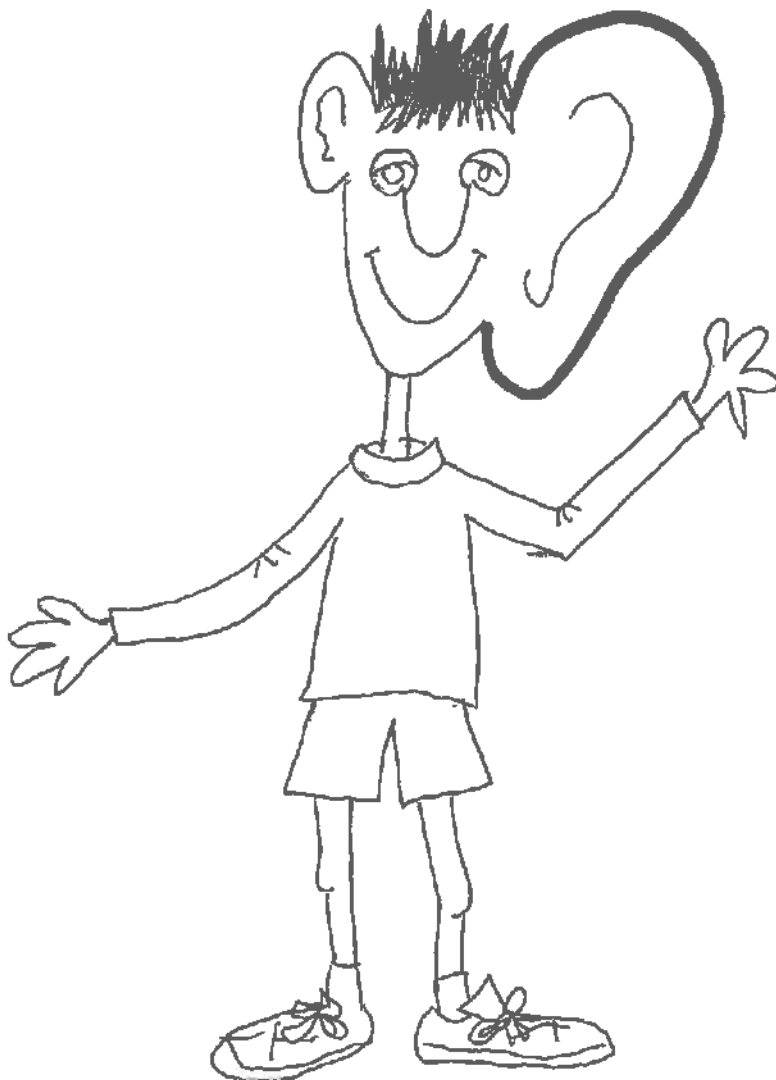


Squiggle Writing Example

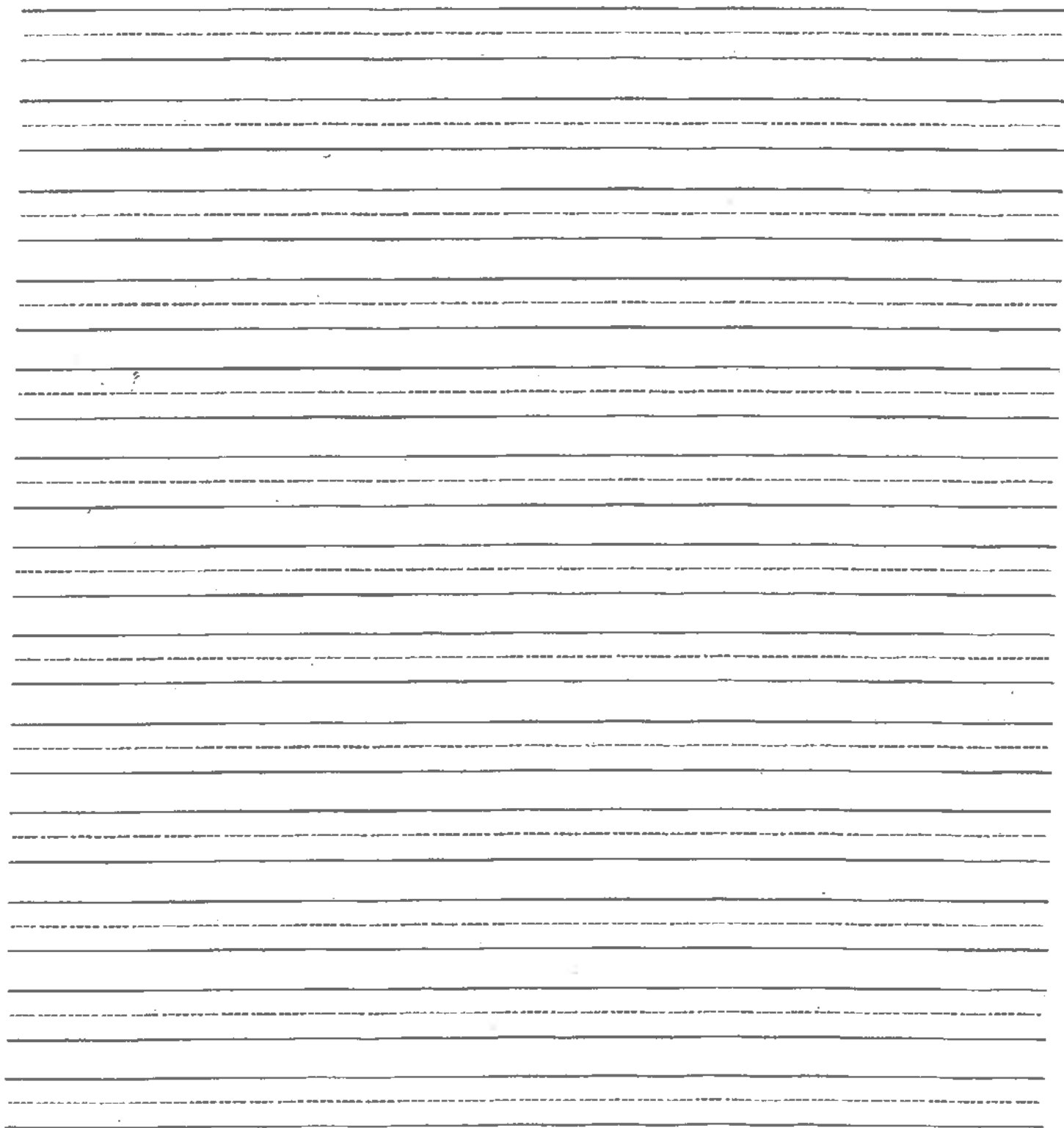
One day a hungry lion approached the boy's village. It slowly crept towards the playground. A gentle breeze blew as the children laughed and played.

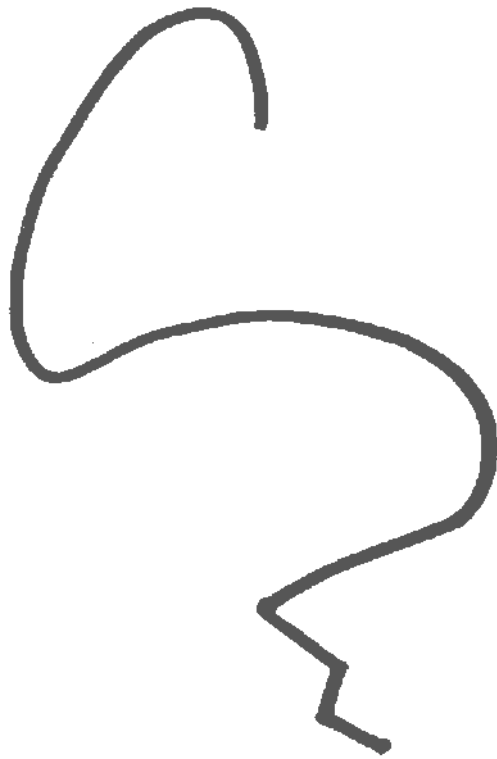
Everyone ran into the school building just in the nick of time! From that day on, everyone wished they had a humungous ear just like that boy!

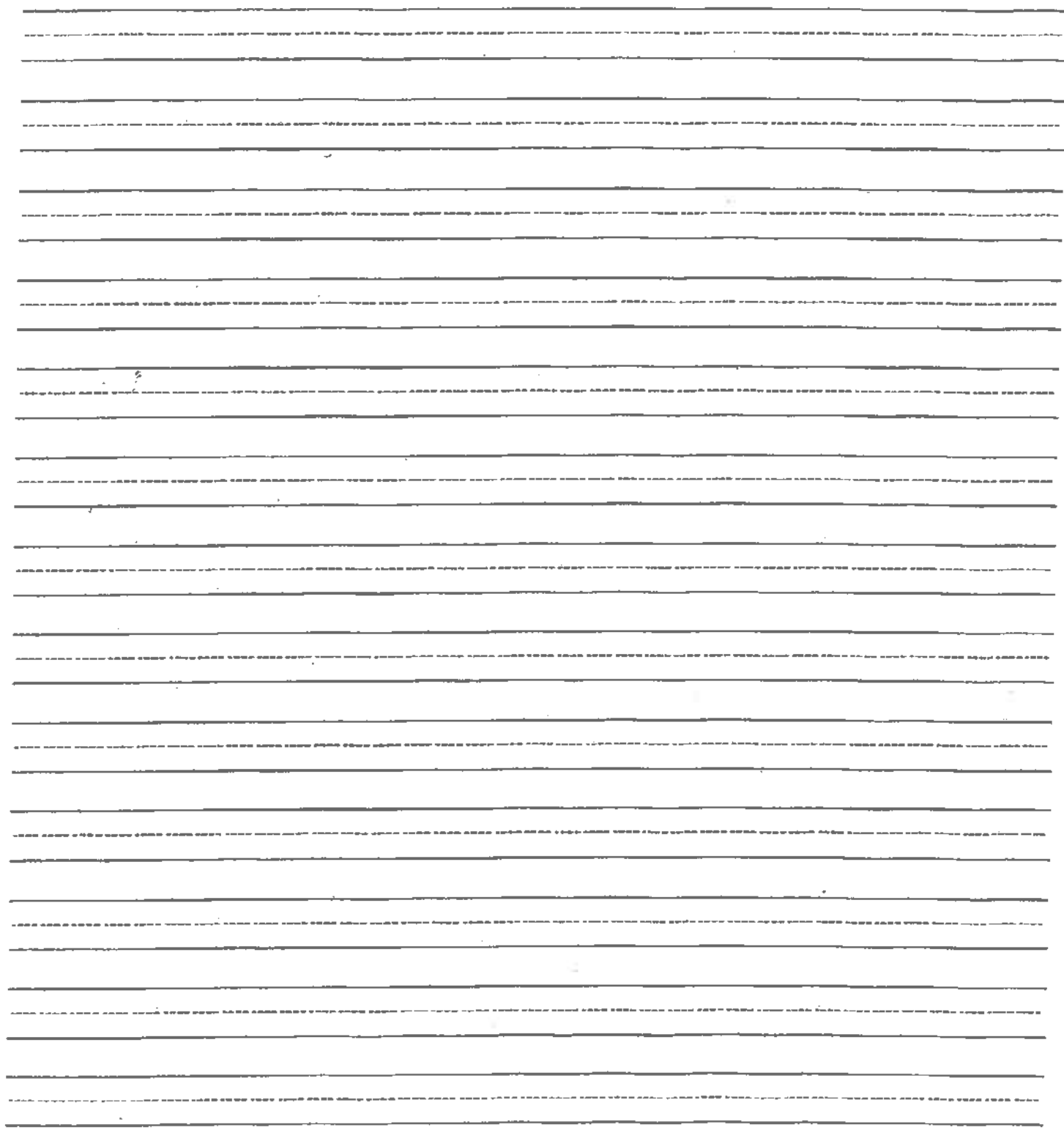

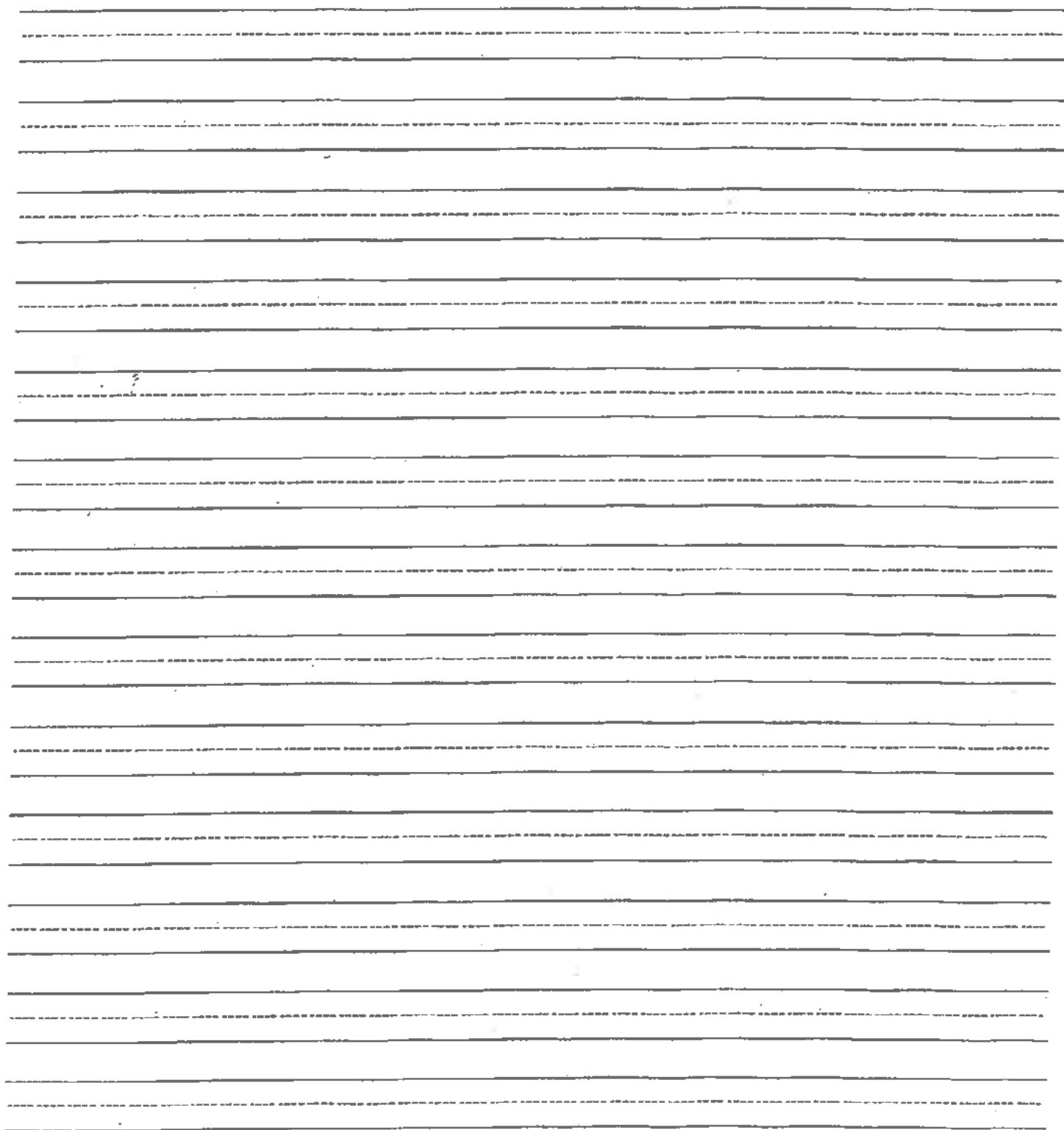

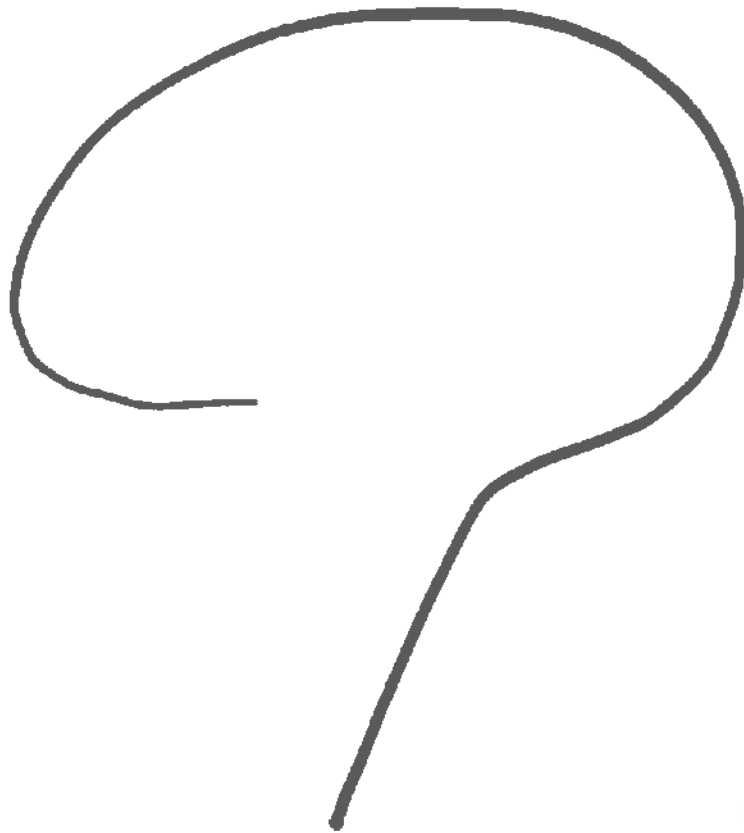
