Each student will select a card and say if the feeling on the card is pleasant or unpleasant to them.

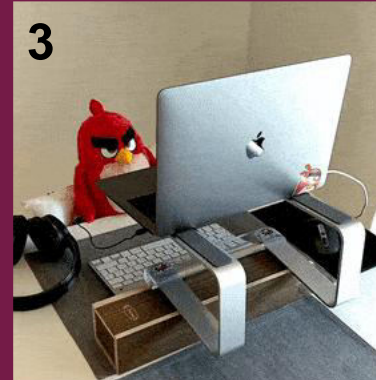
Remind students that it is important for them to recognize different emotions so they can understand how they and others feel.
