Reading: learn how to use strategies while reading passages to answer questions about the text. Students will learn to answer the questions *who*, *what*, *when*, *where*, *why*, and *how* within informational text.

Spelling: double the letters f, I, and s at the end of a one-syllable word

<u>Language:</u> parts of a sentence

<u>Subject</u> – tells who or what the sentence is about <u>Predicate</u>-tells what the subject did or does

<u>Math:</u> Students will continue and finish learning number bond, fact families, and making a ten using different strategies.

<u>Science:</u> habitats and how animals change and respond to changes in their environment, different types of predators and prey, and the circle they create in a habitat.

- 1. **branch** (noun) a part of a tree. It grows out from the trunk of the tree.
- 2.brave- (adjective) someone who is not afraid of danger.
- 3. dash- (verb) move quickly

(noun) small amount of something.
