# Lights, Camera, Action

**Reading:** learn how to use strategies while reading passages to answer questions about the text. Students will learn to answer the questions *who*, *what*, *when*, *where*, *why*, and *how* within informational text.

**Spelling**: double the letters f, l, and s at the end of a one-syllable word

Language: parts of a sentence

<u>Subject</u> – tells who or what the sentence is about Predicate-tells what the subject did or does

<u>Math:</u> Students will continue and finish learning number bond, fact families, and making a ten using different strategies.

**Science:** habitats and how animals change and respond to changes in their environment, different types of predators and prey, and the circle they create in a habitat.
