Lights, Camera, Action

Reading: learn how to use strategies while reading passages to answer questions about the text. Students will learn to answer the questions *who, what, when, where, why,* and *how* within informational text.

Spelling: double the letters f, l, and s at the end of a one-syllable word

Language: parts of a sentence

Subject – tells who or what the sentence is about

Predicate-tells what the subject did or does

Math: Students will continue and finish learning number bond, fact families, and making a ten using different strategies.

Science: habitats and how animals change and respond to changes in their environment, different types of predators and prey, and the circle they create in a habitat.

Friday- Math fact test (timed 2 minutes), Vocabulary test, and Reading Test

Vocabulary

1. **branch-** (noun) a part of a tree. It grows out from the trunk of the tree.
2. **brave-** (adjective) someone who is not afraid of danger.
3. **dash-** (verb) move quickly
(noun) small amount of something.
4. **evening-** (noun) the part of the day between late afternoon and early nighttime
5. **greedy-** (adjective) person wants more of something that what he or she needs.
6. **pass-** (verb) to go by something
(noun) a piece of paper that says the person holding it can do something
7. **present-** (noun) something that you give to someone out of kindness.
(adjective) you are there
8. **stream-** (noun) a body of flowing water that is not too wide or deep.
9. **trail-** (noun) a path for people to follow, especially in the woods
10. **wise-** (adjective) shows good sense and judgment
