Lights, Camera, Action

Reading: learn how to use strategies while reading passages to answer questions about the text. Students will learn to answer the questions *who*, *what*, *when*, *where*, *why*, and *how* within informational text.

Spelling: double the letters f, l, and s at the end of a one-syllable word

Language: parts of a sentence

Subject – tells who or what the sentence is about

Predicate – tells what the subject did or does

Math: Students will continue and finish learning number bond, fact families, and making a ten using different strategies.

Science: habitats and how animals change and respond to changes in their environment, different types of predators and prey, and the circle they create in a habitat.

- branch-** (noun) a part of a tree. It grows out from the trunk of the tree.

- greedy-** (adjective) person wants more of something that what he or she needs.
- pass-** (verb) to go by something
(noun) a piece of paper that says the person holding it can do something
- present-** (noun) something that you give to someone out of kindness.
(adjective) you are there
- stream-** (noun) a body of flowing water that is not too wide or deep.
- trail-** (noun) a path for people to follow, especially in the woods
- wise-** (adjective) shows good sense and judgment
