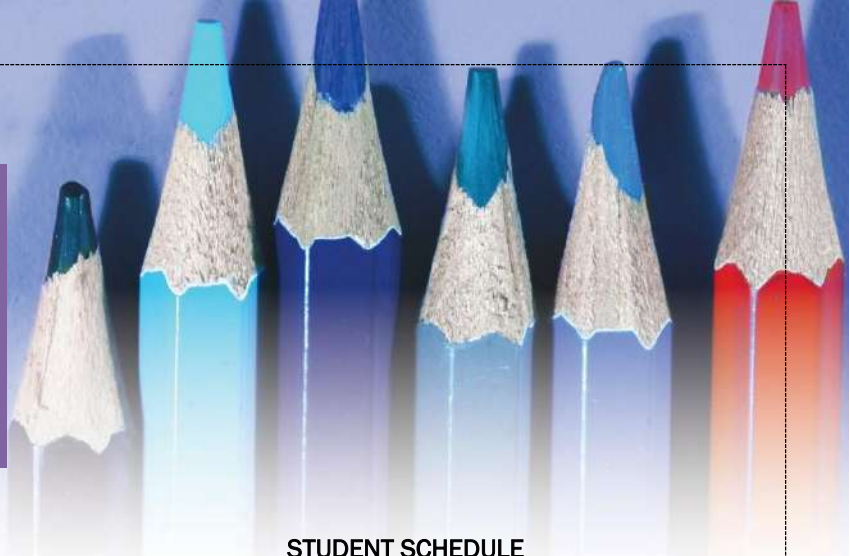
2023-2024 DRESS CODE ADDENDUM:

TRANSPORTATION

BUS STUDENTS:

WALKER/PICK UP STUDENTS:

Students will be dismissed out the Abbott Street Doors (1st- 5th Grade) & Kindergarten Students will be dismissed out the Playground Doors area only to parent/guardian with proper ID.

EARLY DISMISSALS/VIRTUAL DAYS (TENTATIVE):

Have a tentative plan for early dismissals:

- Eight (8) in-service dates
- Two (2) parent-teacher conferences
- Possible inclement weather dismissals
- Possible two (2) or three (3) hour delays with changes in start and bus pick up times.

CHANGES IN DAILY SCHEDULE

Any changes in the student's daily routine must be accompanied by a note from the parent/guardian with a current phone number. The change will be verified by teacher or the main office and student will only be released to the parent/guardian identified in the notes.
