## Miller Focus on Sustainability

- LEED Certified Building
- We normally use dishes and silverware so we don't throw away paper boats and plastic silverware each day
- Solar Panels on our roof provide some on our electricity and are a great learning tool for our students

- Assemblies: We sing, dance, and cheer for our fellow students. We have fun!
- We have 4 expectations of our students: Be safe, kind, responsible and green
- Each school day begins with a classroom Morning Meeting to build community so students can work and learn together
- Peer Buddies: Each 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grade class has a Kinder 2<sup>nd</sup> grade buddy class
- Technology: Kindergarten –Each of our students have an iPad that helps support learning, skill practice, and meaningful differentiation

# Parent Involvement – Once restrictions are lifted on volunteers & visitors in the school:

- Work with students or complete prep work for classroom teachers
- Chaperones field trips
- Planning and donating items for class or school celebrations
- Shelving books in the media center
- Share your expertise with students and teachers

- Staggered Start for kindergarten students, start school on the Wednesday or Thursday after Labor Day
