- b. New Concrete this Fall!
 - i. 16' x 100'
 - ii. Cost around \$3500

 - 2. Four-Squares (x3 or x4)

 - i. If approved, we would like to add a couple inches of good topsoil to the playground to provide students with a softer grass area to play in
