To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed are applications and materials to encourage your students to apply for collegiate scholarships currently offered by the West Virginia Desk and Derrick Club (WVDDC). WVDDC members work for and support West Virginia's energy industries and affiliates. Our primary goal is to advance the education of the individuals who supply the Nation's energy, today and in the years ahead.

We began our Scholarship program in 2007 and awarded a pair of scholarships to students who were enrolled in the College of Engineering at West Virginia University. One of those first recipients, upon graduation, became a member of our Club. In 2015 we will be awarding scholarships to seven (7) deserving students who plan to pursue their educational goals towards employment in the energy industry or who are currently employed in the energy industry.

Criteria for scholarships are:

- 1. A copy of the student's high school transcript with ACT or SAT score(s)
- 2. An original essay of at least 300 words
- 3. A discussion of the applicants history of leadership or service
- 4. At least one letter of recommendation from someone other than a relative
- 5. Application must be signed by applicant's guidance counselor or principal
- 6. If any part of the criteria is missing, application will not be considered

Although grades are considered by our scholarship committee, classroom performance is not the determining factor in our decision making process. The essay offers a crucial opportunity to communicate to our judges on a more personal basis then the academic records alone would allow. Often, a thoughtful and well-crafted essay weighs heavily while having a lower academic record when granting of a scholarship.

2015 WEST VIRGINIA DESK AND DERRICK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

High school seniors planning on attending a four-year West Virginia college or university are eligible to receive a one-time only \$1,000 scholarship.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FEBRUARY 15, 2015 THROUGH APRIL 15, 2015

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicant must be a high school senior planning to enroll in a four-year West Virginia College or university.
- Applicant must submit a 300 word essay (double spaced and one sided)
 explaining, "What do you see as the top challenges for the energy
 industry over the next 10 years?" This must be postmarked no later
 than April 15, 2015.
- On a separate piece of paper please list and explain 2 or 3 leadership and/or service activities in which you have been involved in throughout high school and provide a short description of each activity.
- Please provide a letter of recommendation in a sealed envelope from someone other than a family member or friend. (A teacher and/or clergy qualify.)
- Preference will be given to applicants entering an energy related program. (Recommendation by a WV Desk and Derrick member is desirable, but not required.)
- Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the respective winning applicant's college or university.
- Scholarships will be made on a one-time only basis.
- 8. All applications MUST be signed by applicant's guidance counselor or principal.
