"FART"
OR
"FLATULENCE"

"canker sore" or "mouth ulcers" are grey-white pits with a red boarder in the soft tissue lining the mouth

Aphthous Ulcers

"cold sores" or "fever blisters" are blister like sores on the lips and adjacent facial tissue that are caused by the oral herpes simplex virus type 1

Herpes Labialis

"dry mouth" is the lack of adequate saliva due to diminished secretion of the salivary glands

xerostomia

"Pooping" or "Bowel Movements" emptying of the large intestine

Defecation

involuntary grinding or clenching of the teeth that usually occurs during sleep

Bruxism

"tooth decay" or "cavity" an infectious disease caused by bacteria that destroys the enamel and dentin of the tooth.

**Dental Caries** 

## inflammation of the gums

Gingivitis

"bad breath" is an unpleasant odor coming from the mouth that can be caused by dental diseases or respiratory or gastric disorders

Halitosis

defined as having bowel movements fewer than 3 times a week. Stools are usually hard, dry, small in size and difficult to eliminate Constipation

"heartburn" the burning sensation caused by the return of acidic stomach content into the esophagus

**Pyrosis** 

"stools" solid body wastes expelled through the rectum and out the anus

Feces

condition in which fluid loss exceeds fluid intake and disrupts the bodies normal electrolyte balance

Dehydration

"indigestion" pain or discomfort in digestion

dyspepsia

"vomiting" reflex rejection of the stomach content through the mouth

**Emesis** 

the act of burping or belching or raising gas orally from the stomach

Eructation

"Farting" or passing of gas out through the rectum and anus

Flatulence

## the urge to vomit

Nausea

## vomiting of blood

Hematemesis

## the return of swallowed food into the mouth

Regurgitation

"colon cancer" often first manifest itself in polyps in the colon

Colorectal carcinoma

## inability to control the excretion of feces

**Bowel Incontinence** 

# the presence of gallstones in the gallbladder or bile ducts

cholelithasis

"chewing" breaking food down into smaller pieces, mixes with saliva and prepares it to be swallowed

Mastication

a mass of food that has been chewed and ready to be swallowed

bolus
