What is the Medical Term for?



“canker sore” or “mouth ulcers”  
are grey-white pits with a red  
boarder in the soft tissue lining  
the mouth

Aphthous Ulcers

What is the Medical Term for?



“cold sores” or “fever blisters” are blister like sores on the lips and adjacent facial tissue that are caused by the oral herpes simplex virus type 1

Herpes Labialis

What is the Medical Term for?



“dry mouth” is the lack of  
adequate saliva due to  
diminished secretion of the  
salivary glands

xerostomia

What is the Medical Term for?



“Pooping” or “Bowel Movements”  
emptying of the large intestine

Defecation

What is the Medical Term for?



involuntary grinding or clenching  
of the teeth that usually occurs  
during sleep

Bruxism

What is the Medical Term for?



“tooth decay” or “cavity” an infectious disease caused by bacteria that destroys the enamel and dentin of the tooth.

Dental Caries

What is the Medical Term for?



inflammation of the gums

Gingivitis



What is the Medical Term for?



“bad breath” is an unpleasant odor coming from the mouth that can be caused by dental diseases or respiratory or gastric disorders

Halitosis

What is the Medical Term for?



defined as having bowel movements fewer than 3 times a week. Stools are usually hard, dry, small in size and difficult to eliminate

Constipation

What is the Medical Term for?



“heartburn” the burning sensation caused by the return of acidic stomach content into the esophagus

Pyrosis

What is the Medical Term for?



“stools” solid body wastes  
expelled through the rectum  
and out the anus

Feces

What is the Medical Term for?



condition in which fluid loss  
exceeds fluid intake and  
disrupts the bodies normal  
electrolyte balance

Dehydration

What is the Medical Term for?



“indigestion” pain or discomfort  
in digestion

dyspepsia

What is the Medical Term for?



“vomiting” reflex rejection of the  
stomach content through the  
mouth

Emesis

What is the Medical Term for?



the act of burping or belching or  
raising gas orally from the  
stomach

Eructation



What is the Medical Term for?



“Farting” or passing of gas out through the rectum and anus

Flatulence

What is the Medical Term for?



the urge to vomit

Nausea

What is the Medical Term for?



vomiting of blood

Hematemesis

What is the Medical Term for?



the return of swallowed food into  
the mouth

Regurgitation

What is the Medical Term for?



“colon cancer” often first  
manifest itself in polyps in the  
colon

Colorectal carcinoma

What is the Medical Term for?



inability to control the excretion  
of feces

**Bowel Incontinence**

What is the Medical Term for?



the presence of gallstones in the  
gallbladder or bile ducts

cholelithiasis

What is the Medical Term for?



“chewing” breaking food down into smaller pieces, mixes with saliva and prepares it to be swallowed

a mass of food that has been  
chewed and ready to be  
swallowed
