

What is NAHS ?

National Art Honor Society is a nationwide organization designed to provide national recognition and opportunities for students who exhibit outstanding scholarship in the visual arts.

Who can join?

High school students in grades 9-12.

What does it cost? Dues are \$8 per year for Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior students. Dues are \$20 for Seniors.

When must dues be paid by? By the November meeting. Pay the dues to the bookkeeper and attach the receipt to your application. Bring the application to Mrs. Gauthier at the November meeting.

What do we do?

Community service work related to art. Have monthly meetings (Second Thursday at lunch (11:40am) in room 701). Plan our induction ceremony in the spring. Nominate officers. Plan fundraising activities such as having a table at an art show and sale. Create a Facebook page to keep everyone current with what is going on. Design and sell cards with original artwork. Do face painting at various events. Help hang and take down art shows.

How many community service hours are required by the time I graduate? 30 hours

How do I keep track of my service hours? On the Service Hours sheet. Have the adult in charge sign off each time you complete a service project.

How many art classes must I take in order to be a member? One class per year is recommended. It can be any of the visual arts courses offered at WLHS. Members may remain active during the time there are no visual art classes in your schedule as long as you still come to the monthly meetings and fulfill your hours of service (average of 10 hours per year, so that you have 30 hours by the time you graduate)

What GPA (in art classes) must I keep in order to stay a member? 3.5

To graduate with NAHS honors and earn the right to wear a cord at graduation, a member must remain in good standing until the graduation date.
