#### **Attendance Reminders**

As we start the second semester, please take a moment & review some of these helpful attendance reminders:

- Students not in class at the start of the instructional day (8:00 AM) will be marked tardy. Students who accrue four tardies in any class are subject to the consequences outlined in the student handbook.
- Absences are accumulated on a class-by-class basis. Students who accrue more than 7 absences in a class are at risk of not receiving credit unless they participate in credit recovery.
- All absences count toward the above-mentioned 7 absences. Absences will be counted as unexcused until a note specifying the reason for the absence has been provided to the Attendance Counselor.
- Documentation specifying the reason for an absence should be presented to the Attendance Counselor as soon as the student returns to school.
- Only parent/guardians or emergency contacts will be allowed to check out students from school.
- Students must sign in or out with the main office when they arrive late or leave early.
- Students who wish to leave early must present a signed parent note to main office prior to 8 AM. The student will be issued an early dismissal notice once the note has been verified.

## FAFSA Day

FAFSA (Free Application for Student Aid) Day is a FREE event offered to students and families who need financial aid resources for post-secondary education. On FAFSA Day, Saturday, February 20, college financial aid officers and other volunteers will help students complete their Free Application for Student Aid forms. ### Flex Day Application for Seniors

Seniors interested in applying for flex schedule second semester must submit their applications before the 10th day of the spring term. Questions about whether flex scheduling is a viable option for your student should be

directed to our guidance team. The flex schedule application and parent permission form can be found on Naviance and students are responsible for verifying that the flex schedule is acceptable to the colleges to which they have applied. Additional details regarding the flex schedule program may be found below:

- Seniors not meeting requirements for Early Graduation, but needing less than 4 courses in meeting graduation requirements, may opt to apply for flex day. This would apply for students meeting the UCPS Graduation Requirement (maximum potential 4). Because the CASP program contains a flex component, these students do not have to be considered for a flexible day schedule.
- If a student enters his/her Senior Year with a minimum of 24 credits, the principal is granted the flexibility to offer the remaining credits during the spring semester. Principals are advised to offer courses required for graduation during the fall semester.
- Application for and approval of flex day must be made within the first 10 days of the semester.
- Courses must be completed in sequential order during the day and students must provide their own transportation. For example, students may not leave midday and return for 4th block class.
- If a student wishes to return to school grounds after the end of the school day for after-school activities, principal approval is necessary. This does not apply to night events.
- Flex day is available for school-sponsored athletic participants during the second semester.

The Parent Portal feature of PowerSchool is currently active and we would like to encourage you to stay abreast of your student's academic progress in his/her courses. Parent portal allows parents to monitor their student's academic progress and attendance throughout the grading period.
