

Wild Animals of IHS



Step 1

Choose and download an image of a wild animal from this [GOOGLE Folder](#)

Step 2

- Take a photo on campus that would look good with your animal placed in it.
- Make sure to use an F/10 or higher; you want as much of the photo in focus as possible.

Step 3

- Open the wild animal. Use the Quick selection tool to remove as much of the background as possible. Click select and mask to fine tune it. If your animal as a lot of fur, make sure to feather the edges.

Step 4

- Drag your animal over. Use Edit→ transform→ scale to adjust the size.
- Play around with the layers adjustments to match the color intensity.
- Add a shadow using the burn tool.
- Flatten the layers
- Export as JPG →
