Window Drawing

Draw what you see, outside your window.

Materials

- Paper
- A drawing utensil
- Color supplies
- A window









Step 1 - Divide your paper into quarters


Fold in half, make a crease, then unfold. Fold again the other way. Don't forget to match up your corners.



Step 2 - Make the window panes.

Now that the paper is divided into quarters, draw a rectangle in each quarter as big as you can. Leave enough room inside the rectangle to draw. Leave a little room between the


Leave a little room between th rectangles for the window's frame.



Step 3 - Draw the sky boxes

The top 2 squares will be for your sky. Draw what you see.

Is the sky cloudy? Are there birds? Can you see the sun? Is there something else?



Step 4 - Draw the ground - Closest first!

What is on the ground in front of your window?

Start with what is closest, then draw what you see around it.

Things near you are **BIG** and near the **BOTTOM** of your paper.

Things far away from you are small and near the **MIDDLE** of your paper.




Step 5 - Add details

Remember, only draw what you choose to see. Cars Tennis court It is your drawing! Garbage dump Parking lot
