2021 Ohio State Testing Information for Wellston Middle School

- WMS Students Grades 6-8 will be taking the Ohio State assessments Spring 2021! The following dates indicate when
 your student will be testing--attendance on these days proves very important.
- In that students will be taking tests on their Chromebooks, please ensure that students' computers are fully charged and in working order upon arrival to school each day.
- Please note that WMS will observe a hybrid schedule for testing, which means that students will only attend in person on defined days during testing weeks, according to the student's designation of Group A (last names A-L) or Group B (last names M-Z).
 - Note that WMS students will participate in remote learning online at home on off days during the hybrid testing schedule.
- Ohio State Testing Dates follow:
 - April 19th April 22nd (Students grades 6-8 will take ELA electronic tests according to hybrid group designations noted below)
 - April 26th April 29th (Students grades 6-8 will take Math electronic tests according to hybrid group designations noted below):
 - May 3rd May 6th (only 8th grade Science Students will observe the hybrid schedule). 6th & 7th grade students will report in person full week.
 - To clarify, during the 2 weeks of ELA and Math testing (weeks of April 19th-22nd for ELA; week of April 26th-29th for Math) students 6-8 will only report during their designated times (3 days of in person and 2 days of remote learning).
 - Students in Group A (last names A-L) will only report in person on Monday/Tues/Fri during those weeks. Part 1 and Part 2 tests happen on Monday and Tuesday; Friday is a regular in person learning day for all.
 - Students in Group B (last names M-Z) will only report in person on Wednesday/Thursday/Friday during those weeks. Part 1 and Part 2 tests happen on Wednesday & Thursday; Friday is a regular in person learning day for all.
 - During the week of 8th grade Science testing (week of May 3rd-6th), 6th and 7th grade students will report in person full week, while only 8th grade students observe a hybrid schedule that week.
 - 8th grade students in Group A (last names A-L) report on Monday/Tuesday/Friday during that week. Testing happens Monday & Tuesday; Friday is a regular in person learning day for all.
 - 8th grade students in Group B (last names M-Z) report on Wednesday/Thursday/Friday during that week. Testing happens on Wednesday & Thursday; Friday is a regular in person learning day for all.
 - Virtual students taking computer tests (to include Students enrolled in the APEX or VLA online learning programs), will report in person to WMS for test administration during the same test windows as indicated above (and on tables below) for in person students--according to days designated for Group A (last names A-L) and Group B (last names M-Z).
 - Virtual students should report to the building each morning of testing at regular time (present by 7:50 a.m.). Virtual students can ride the bus or be dropped off by guardians. Students should first report to the cafeteria, eat breakfast if desired, and then students will be directed to test with proctors in small groups.
 - Virtual students should be picked up by guardians following the completion of tests (exceptions
 include those students with extended time accommodations; in this case, students will contact
 guardians for pick-up following test completion):
 - ELA completed at 10:15 a.m.--pick up time
 - Math completed at 9:45 a.m.--pick up time
 - 8th grade Science completed at 9:30 a.m.--pick up time
 - Virtual students taking paper/pencil tests will be called to schedule times for testing on the following dates:
 - April 12th & 13th (6th & 7th gr paper tests)
 - April 14th & 15th (Science 8th gr paper tests)
