#### **UNIQUE - MARCH**

**Elementary -- The Hot, Hot Sun (Physical Science) -** Exploring energy from the sun and how it affects different objects.

Middle school -- Buzzing with Energy (Physical Science) -Provides a basic study of energy and technology in daily life.
