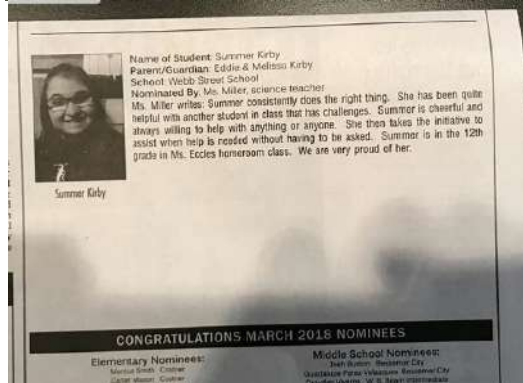
Webb Street School Talent Show

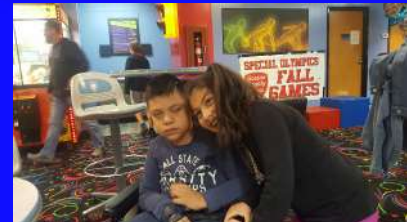
