Name of Strategy	How We Use It
Using Context Clues	Look at the other words and punctuation around the unknown word to help you figure out its meaning.
	 Reread the sentences before and after the unknown word. What words around the unknown word do you know? Are there punctuation clues like commas, dashes, or parentheses to indicate that the author is defining the word?
Recalling Background Knowledge	Think about what you already know about this topic. What have you read about this topic? Have you had personal experiences with this topic or idea? What are they? What do you know about the ideas being presented in this sentence?
Searching the Glossary	Use a Glossary in the text to confirm or clarify the definition of the unknown word.
	 Is the word in the back of the text? Is the word in bold on the page with the definition on the side of the page? Is the word highlighted in the text? Is the word in a different color font?
