On the "Discover" page click "Student Edition PDF" under the "Resources" section.



After you click the "Student Edition PDF" button (shown on previous slide) you will see a list of all modules in the book.

Find the module you want to read and click the "<u>OPEN</u>" button.

# If you can't get a textbook module PDF file to fully open (for example, you get a "Whoops, this file is too large to preview" error) – click the <u>3 white dots</u> & then click "Open in new window"



If the PDF doesn't load at all you'll see a "<u>Download</u>" button in the middle of the page (use that). If only part of the file loads you can click the <u>Download</u> icon & <u>SAVE THE FILE</u> to your device's storage or google drive to often it

a.) open it in a new tab of your browser
