



# 1.) Google "Durand Land"




# 2.) Click "Course, Textbook & Contact Info" then "World Geography Textbook"



# 3.) Click the image of the textbook OR the link below the picture of the textbook




# 4.) Sign-in with your Abington account if prompted (if you're already signed in you will skip this step.)




Remote Teaching Quick Start

On the “**Discover**” tab you may open a “**Module**” of the textbook (*modules are similar to chapters*).

You can also hit the **arrow** on the right-side of the screen to see more modules.

Clicking “**Student eBook**” under “Resources” will also lead you to opening Modules & Lessons.



Once you open a module you can click **“Contents”** in the upper-left corner to access a menu that allows you to jump to different lessons in the module.



Remote Teaching Quick Start

There is another way to open Modules that also allows you to *see the page numbers*.

On the **“Discover”** page click **“Student Edition PDF”** under the **“Resources”** section.




After you click the “**Student Edition PDF**” button (shown on previous slide) you will see a list of all modules in the book.

Find the module you want to read and click the “**OPEN**” button.



Essential Question

On the “**Discover**” page you will frequently be asked to open the “**Reference Materials**” page.

This will allow you to view sections such as the **Atlas, Index, Glossary**, etc. from the back of the textbook.
