Composition The entire model is 3-dimensional (not flat) and made from a variety of materials and correctly depicts a burn/wound discussed in class . The model is constructed solely by the student and is not a pre-made kit or other structure.					
Labeling Wound is accompanied by a trifold poster for display. Labels on poster must be neatly printed or typed and big enough to see. Type of wound/burn must be labeled and explained as well as proper care/first aid shown. Use color and make it look professional.					
Realism All components of the model are realistic in their appearance as much as possible with regard to shape, color, etc..					
Presentation Each member of the group explains their model to the class and how they created it. Proper care for each wound/burn is clearly described to the class.					
Summary A one-page summary should be turned in to your teacher. Summary must include a description of the burn or wound you chose to create. It must also detail how you created the model and what materials were used. Summary must also include the correct care for the burn or wound. Finally, you must conclude your summary with whether you think this project helped you learn proper wound care.
