Alliances

(Tannenberg)

These were members of the Triple Entente. (England, France, Russia) These were members of the Triple Alliance. (Germany, Austria-Hungary, Italy) These were the Central Powers. (Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey, Bulgaria) This treaty ended World War I. (Versailles) This was the most violent conflict in WWI with over 1 million casualties. (Somme) Terms This is extreme pride in one's country. (Nationalism) This is the building up of one's military. (Militarism) This was the area located between the trenches. (No man's land) This is the acquisition and competition for colonies. (Imperialism) The battles in France and Belgium were referred to as the _____ Front. (Western) This document attempted to create an alliance between Germany and Mexico. (Zimmerman Note) He was assassinated, sparking WWI. (Archduke Franz Ferdinand) Gavrilo Princip was a member of what nationalistic organization. (Black Hand) War This passenger ship was sunk, killing 1200, including 128 Americans by a German U-boat. (Lusitania) This plan called for the invasion of France, then a quick shift to Russia. (Schlieffen) At this battle, poison gas was introduced. (Ypres) In March 1918, the last German offensive occurred at (Marne) At this Russian battle, the Russians lost thousands and were captured by Germans.

This is a cease-fire or agreement to stop fighting. (Armistice)

Genocide

He led the Turkish genocide against the Armenians in 1915. (Enver Bey- Pasha)

He was the U.S. ambassador to Turkey during the genocide. (Henry Morganthau)

During the Armenian genocide this many lives were lost. (1.5 million)
