YOUR CHILD'S ATTENDANCE MATTERS & EVERY MINUTE COUNTS

Lawful (Excused) Absences are excusable absences permitted by the NC State Board of Education.

The following are Lawful Absences:

- Illness or Injury (1A*)
- Medical/Dental Appointment (1B)
- Death in Family (1C) Must provide obituary or funeral information
- Educational Opportunity which includes trips, college visits (1G) Requires prior approval
- Court Proceedings (1E) If student is involved in proceeding or subpoenaed
- Religious Observances (1F)
- In-School Suspension (3A)
- Out-of-School Suspension (3)

*denotes PowerSchool attendance code

<u>Lawful Absences Procedure</u>: A parent written, email, electronic communication, or medical notes for lawful absences must be turned in within <u>3 school days</u> of the absence.

When a student reaches 10 unexcused absences it is a violation of the NC Compulsory Attendance Law and criminal charges can be filed.

TARDIES & EARLY CHECK OUTS

Students who arrive after 7:30 am are considered tardy and must be signed in by a parent in the front office upon arrival. We know that emergencies arise but please understand the impact that being late or leaving early has on your child and the rest of the class. A few minutes here and there quickly add up and send a message to your child that it is okay to be late for school or work and impacts their education. Please teach your child responsible habits by having them on time to school and attending for the entire day. For a tardy or early release to be excused it must be for one of the excusable reasons above and be accompanied by a note.
