Virginia State Parks is pleased to announce that the 2025 Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) program is now accepting applications for Crew Members. Please continue reading to learn more about what YCC can offer your students.

YCC crews consist of 10 youth, ages 14-17, from diverse backgrounds and 3-4 adult crew leaders. This team of young people will live in a Virginia state park for a two-week session in a structured program of work and learning. On weekdays, the crews carry out park conservation, development, and maintenance projects. After hours, they take part in planned environmental education and recreational activities. Weekends include outdoor adventures such as caving, canoeing, nature hikes, or visiting neighboring state parks.

The Virginia State Parks YCC mission is to connect Virginia's youth with the natural world through a structured program of meaningful service projects on public lands. Youth build trails, friendships, environmental literacy, and self-confidence as they work to preserve access to the outdoors for generations to come.

We would greatly appreciate your assistance in promoting the program to any interested youth. To expand the horizons of participants and introduce them to Virginia's environmental diversity, we strive for geographic distance between the youth's home and the park they serve. We provide meals, housing, and a program completion stipend of \$750 for the participants. The youth must realize that, although no prior experience is necessary, the program is outdoors and service-based and will be physically demanding. It is not summer camp!


