### **PURPOSE:**

The goal of this program is to identify and develop a group of young leaders who can impact the future of Rankin County by learning how to assume responsible community leadership roles.

#### THE PROGRAM WILL:

- Familiarize participants with the community's opportunities, needs, problems and resources.
- Establish an effective dialogue and form friendships among participants and community leaders.
- Develop leadership and management skills by providing training in skills such as goal setting, effective communication, decision making, team building, motivation, organization and work ethic development.

#### ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

Rankin Youth Leadership is composed of six monthly full-day sessions September through March including a MANDATORY opening retreat in August where students are introduced to each other and the program coordinators. Graduation will be held in April.

Once a month the students are excused from their school classes and extracurricular activities to participate in programs designed to develop strong leadership skills and mandatory attendance at all sessions is expected.

#### APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS:

Participation in Rankin Youth Leadership is a competitive process open to 11th grade students (juniors) in public or private schools within Rankin County. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 grade point average for the current school year and must reside in Rankin County.

Participants are selected based on two rounds: an evaluation and ranking of the written applications and an interview. Letters of notification will be mailed to each applicant that has been selected to move onto the next stage, the Interview process. Please remember, your application is being screened to be selected for an interview, so make sure it is neat, accurate and your best work. Incomplete or late submissions will not be accepted!

### **TUITION:**

There is a \$100 tuition to participants of the program and must be paid in full at the Welcome Reception held in August. A limited number of scholarships are considered on a case by case basis. The tuition for the 2019-2020 class has been provided the Rankin Leadership Krewe De Roux 2019 project.

### ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Attendance is mandatory. If a participant misses more than one session, they will be dropped from the class and will not graduate from the program.
- Be on time for all sessions and participate wholeheartedly.
- Exhibit respectful and exemplary "leadership" behavior.
- Absences will be made up by performing 4 hours of assigned community service.

Students must meet the above requirements in order to graduate from the program.

We ask that you make every effort to arrive at least 15 minutes early so that we may stay on schedule. All interviews will be conducted by an outside panel of judges and are not affiliated with the Rankin County Chamber of Commerce in any way. After the judges have made their final selections and submitted them to the Chamber office, the applicants will be notified by text and email no later than Friday, May 3rd.

Applicants should dress in professional business attire for their interview. No shorts, jeans, or tennis shoes should be worn. Skirts and dresses should be of an appropriate length and no sleeveless shirts or dresses are permitted. Suits and ties are not a requirement. Dress in your very best and what makes you feel comfortable! Neat, professional hairstyles, manicured or trimmed nails, light make-up, and little or no perfume or cologne are suggested.

Remember you are also being scored on the completeness and knowledge of your application, so be sure to turn in your best work. Keep a copy of your application and review your answers before your interview. Relax and be yourself!
