2024 YOUTHTRUTH SURVEY RESULTS

Students at Mill Park were surveyed in December 2023 about their perceptions of their school in terms of Engagement, Academic Challenge, Instructional Methods, Culture, Belonging, and Relationships. In addition, students provided feedback about School Safety and Emotional and Mental Health.



We heard from 75% of 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students, and with the help of the nonprofit YouthTruth, analyzed their responses to use for decision-making and improvements. Mill Park had the highest percentage of parent survey participation in the district with 69% responding!


IN A STUDENT'S OWN WORDS:
