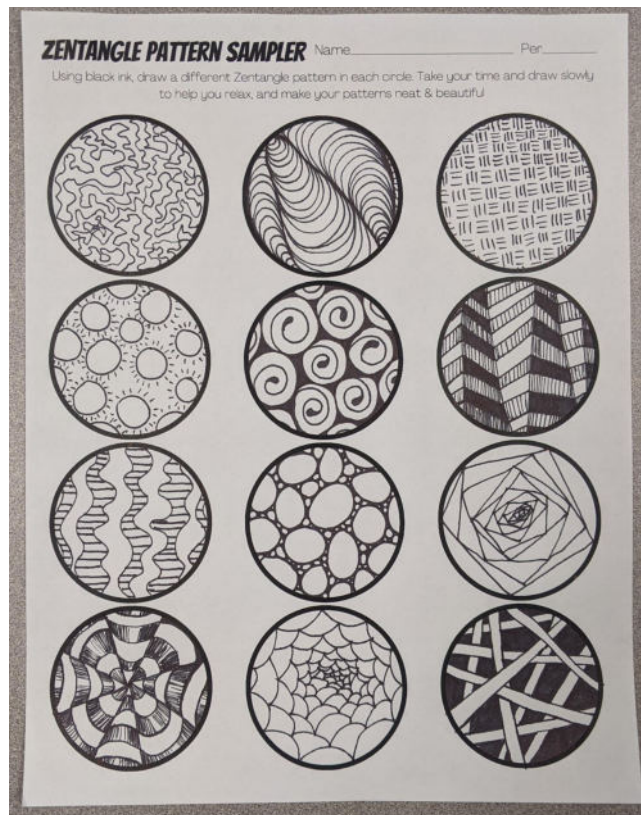


# Zentangle Ornament



**Step 1:** Complete the Zentangle pattern Sampler, & **get it graded!**



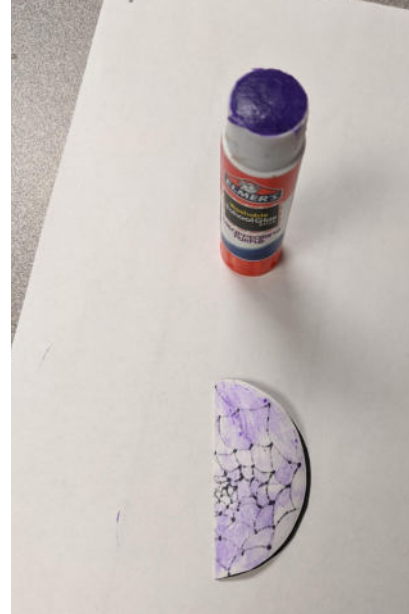
**Step 2:** Carefully cut out the circles  
\*Note: You don't need to use all of them for one ornament- you can choose your favorites



**Step 3:** Fold the circles in half so the pattern is on the inside



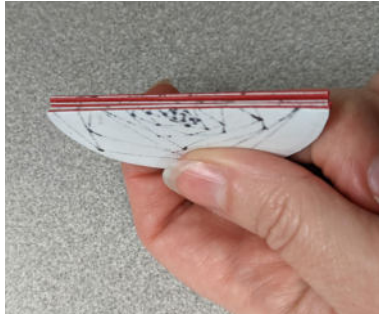
**Step 4:** Put glue on one half of the circle (put a scratch paper under) then line it up and stick it to another circle





**Step 5:** Keep adding circles until you have as many as you want (I used 8)

\*Note: it is easier to line them up and glue them if you keep them in a flat stack. You can also add colored construction paper circles like I did with my second one



**Important:** Don't glue the last 2 flaps together yet!

**Step 6:** Cut a piece of fishing line (Or string, if you prefer) at least 2 feet long. Also, choose a few beads for the top & bottom of your ornament



**Step 7:** Adding the strings and beads is a little tricky- video instructions here:

**Step 8:** Once your string and beads are in place, glue the last 2 flaps together, and your ornament is finished!
