### APPLICATION PROCEDURES

### General Eligibility:

Undergraduate women of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated whom are currently matriculating full-time in an accredited four-year institution are eligible for this award. Each eligible applicant will be financial for the current year of award and actively pursuing a degree. All applicants must meet all criteria delineated in this application form.

#### Criteria:

- 1. The recipient must:
  - · Be currently admitted and attending an accredited college or university
  - Be & AuX time student
  - De a financial member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, in good standing and a member of an active collegiate chapter
  - Pave a Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better (on a 4.0 scale)
  - Submit an official transcript (Traditional or Electronic) with the school seal and an authorized official's signature
  - · Submit the personal essay
  - Submit a completely executed and signed scholarship application as a castile (original or electronic signature acceptable)
  - Provide a letter of recommendation from a Life/Golden/Platinum/Diamond Life Member in good financial standing OR a financial member of the advising Graduate Chapter (if there are no Life Members in the chapter).

### Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All entries into this application form and its attachments must be true and accurate.
- 2. All copies of transcripts must be the official, original documents, issued by the college or university with appropriate seal or watermark (Official electronic transmission will be acceptable), must represent a full-time student status.
- 3. All awardees must conduct themselves on/off the campus in a way, which garners the respect of other students on/off the campus, and all officials of the university.
- 4. Any change in student's enrollment status or contact information must be reported to the local advising graduate chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated and the National Life Member's Scholarship Committee.



### I. PERSONAL ESSAY

(Must be typewritten, two (2) pages maximum, on a separate page clearly titled "Personal Essay".)

Students must show that they are committed to continuing their education by maintaining high academic and personal achievement. This essay is your opportunity to tell us about yourself and explain why you should be selected to receive this scholarship. Your written essay should clearly demonstrate experiences or accomplishments in at least three of the six areas listed below:

Special Talent: Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart from your peers.

Examples may include, but are not limited to: working well with others, artistic talents, athletic ability, public speaking or writing skills, a creative activity/challenge that you engaged in, etc.

Leadership and Service: Clearly articulate how you have demonstrated your leadership ability both in and out of school. Examples may include, but are not limited to: community service involvement, leadership roles or unique responsibilities at home, school or church, etc.

Challenges: Describe how you have achieved a goal despite struggles or obstacles that may have hindered you. Be specific.

Examples may include, but are not limited to: achievement of a goal despite struggles or parriers, withstanding significant peer pressure(s) that may have otherwise deterred your achievements, overcoming a major life event, etc.

Influences: Discuss situations or persons that have been major influences in your life.

Examples may include, but are not limited to: how your personal background has affected your view of the world, an individual or group who has been your biggest influence and why? A book that has affected you deeply and why, etc.

Legacy: Are there members of the Zeta Phi Beta, Phi Beta Sigma or Zeta Amicae in your family? Are you a past Zeta Archonette, Amicette, Pearlette? How has the influence of Zeta Phi Beta or Phi Beta Sigma influenced your path in life and in Zeta? What are your goals within Zeta at any and/or all levels?

Financial Need: Provide a more detailed and personal account of your financial need.

You may describe, from a financial standpoint, what impact would this award would have on your education, or share any special circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance.

#### II. LETTERS OF REFERENCE

Two (2) Reference letters from any of the following sources: Professor, Zeta Graduate Chapter Advisor or Zeta Graduate Chapter Mentor, Campus Advisor, Mentor, Church, Community Leader. Letters from relatives are not acceptable references for this application. (Must be on Official Letterhead)

One (1) reference letter from a Life/Golden/Platinum/Diamond Life Member in good financial standing. If there are no Life Members in the advising Zeta Graduate Chapter a letter chapter letterhead must be provided from the current Graduate Chapter President for verification.

III. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT Student must provide ONE unopened copy of her official transcript with the seal intact.
